





RANDALL ROAD CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT UPDATE

MCHENRY COUNTY IS PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE THAT THE MCHENRY COUNTY BOARD HAS DECIDED TO MOVE THE RANDALL ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT INTO THE NEXT PHASE OF DESIGN!



For the last seven years, the County has been studying the corridor in order to determine what types of changes would best improve the 3.5 miles between Ackman Road and County Line Road. The next stage will determine the details required to move forward and allow final construction drawings to be prepared.

One of the first tasks will be to refine the design of the configuration of the Randall Road/Algonquin Road intersection. This will be done by revisiting the previously evaluated alternatives and analyzing each for anticipated performance over the next 5, 10 and 15 years. Other factors to be analyzed include right-of-way needs, associated costs, economic impacts, potential driveway modifications, accesses to businesses, future maintenance costs as well as actual construction costs. Once the analysis is complete, stakeholders will be able to compare the alternatives to make an informed decision on which intersection design best meets the needs of the County and its residents.
